
SERVICE DOOR SCREEN INSERT INSTALLATION

TYPICAL DOOR INSIDE VIEW



Standard sizes:

25" x 35"

25" x 31" (Shown)

25" x 25"

Note: When installing inserts both above and below the panic opener, a 10" space to serve as a kick panel may be required at the bottom of the door.

- 1) The insert may be installed with the door in place or removed from hinges.
- 2) Position the inside panel on door and mark around outside of frame.

CAUTION: LEAVE CLEARANCES FOR DOOR CLOSER, PANIC OPENER AND KICK PLATE.

- 3) Cut opening half inch smaller than marks.
- 4) Caulk under outer screen frame for weather seal.
- 5) Install outer screen frame into outerside of door.
- 6) Hold inside frame in position with the keeper on the bottom and install 4 bolts 3" long, on the sides with flat nuts. Tighten as necessary to allow the shorter bolts to be used on the top and bottom.
- 7) Install the top and bottom bolts (10-24 \times 2-1/4" long) and tighten with stop lock nuts.
- 8) Remove the long bolts and install bolts (10-24 x 2-1/4" long) and tighten with stop lock nuts.
- 9) Check that the insert is square in door and tighten all the mounting bolts.
- 10) Measure and install storage brackets and storage keeper with 1/4-20 pk's to hold fill panel, lexan or solid. Attach foam rubber pads onto door to insure firm hold.
- 11) Check latch for proper operation in both positions.
